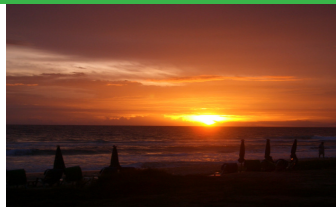

**D01 Kuala Lumpur/Phuket (D)**  
 • Upon arrival, proceed for Phuket city Tour, Chino-Portugese Style Building of Phuket, Saphan Hin Park, Cashew Nut Factory, Gems Factory, Birdnet shop, Chalong Temple, Sea Gypsy Village, Rawai beach, Prompthe Cape.

**D02 Coral Island Tour (B/L/D)**

#### Sightseeing Highlights

##### Phuket

- **Coral Island**, known locally as Koh Hae, is a beautiful getaway destination located nine kilometers southeast of Phuket. The island features two main beaches, Long Beach and Banana Beach. It's not called Coral Island for nothing; the snorkeling off Banana Beach is thrilling and if you go out far enough from Long Beach you will also have a lot to discover, at its impressive coral reef.
- **Phang Nga Bay (OPTIONAL)** A distinctive feature of Phang Nga Bay is the sheer limestone cliffs that jut vertically out of the emerald green water. James Bond Island and Koh Panniyi are just two of the more famous spots in this bay. By far the best means of enjoying the spectacular scenery, with only brief encounters with the tourist crowds as James Bond and Koh Panniyi, is to take one of the boat trips from the northern end of Phuket.
- **National Park (OPTIONAL)** is also one of the hubs of national parks in the south. You can discover the natural beauty of tropical and virgin forest together with various wildlife animals. Phuket national parks are the host of abundant species of exotic, reserve animals such as wild boars, mouse deer, barking deer, monkeys, gibbons, langur, rare species of birds, leather bag turtles, and marine life, and most would likely become extinct nowadays.
- **Phuket City Tour** in and around Phuket town. You will see the Chino-Portuguese style building of Phuket, followed by visiting Saphan Hin Park, Cashew Nut factory, Gems factory, Birdnest shop, Chalong temple, Sea Gypsy village, Rawai beach, Prompthe cape where you can view the panorama of its stunning beauty.
