Sightseeing Highlights

Bangkok

- **Wat Arun** often called The Temple of Dawn, is one of the most remarkable visual identities of Bangkok. The imposing Khmer-style prang or tower is 67 meters tall and decorated with bits of porcelain that was used as ballast by boats coming from China. It is surrounded by four smaller prangs. Construction of the prangs were started by King Rama II and completed by King Rama III.
- **Safari World & Marine Park** is divided into two parks Safari Park and Marine Park . Safari Park is an open space zoo which you can drive in by yourself and you can feed the animals by your hands , such animals are tame animals like giraffe , deer or zebra and etc, as for the wild ones , you are told to be seated in your cars. For the Marine parks , varieties of animal performances such as dolphins, Urang Utan , bird show and many others , in which you'll have great time.

Pattaya

- **Coral Island** is also called as Ko Larn is the best known out of a group of small islands a few miles off the coast of Pattaya. It is popular with day visitors who want to spend a day on a wide sandy beach and do some snorkeling, swimming, diving, and sunbathing. At the Coral Island, you can relax on the beach or play water-sports such as skiing, windsurfing, or scuba diving at your own leisure which it only takes just seven kilometers from Pattaya Bay, sports three beaches and is Pattaya's closest island just a 45-minute boat ride from shore.
- **Pattaya Floating Market** the biggest floating market in the world, is located on the outskirts of Pattaya on Sukhumvit Road. There are More than 80 paddle boats are on standby to ferry visitors around the compound along many Thai style teak wood buildings, linked by a network of canals, bridges and a number of different sized islands with exotic plants and trees. The boat trip will slowly expose the richness of the surrounding architectural and cultural river side living. Water vendors moving with their paddle boats from dock to dock and offering their unique range of freshly cooked delicious dishes.
- **Noong Nooch Village** is well known to those who want to take in an impressive Thai Cultural Show and find the biggest and most beautiful botanical garden in Southeast Asia which it is also dedicated to education, preservation, research as well as the conservation of its vast palm collection and other tropical plants. Witness the pomp and splendour of Thai tradition and ceremonies, graceful dances from all over the country, sword fighting, Thai kick-boxing, and much more, featuring hundreds of multi-talented performers in a fascinating one and- a- half hour show.
- **Alangkarn Show** is located 155 kilometers on Sukhumvit Road Jomtien, Pattaya with an area of 80 rais. The entire project includes prototype Hexa Stage Theatre, Cultural Rostrum and a Restaurant. ALANGKARN is aiming towards a new concept of presenting the Thai Culture to our clientele, instead of the standard Thai traditional dancing that could easily be founded elsewhere. The unique features are the combination of multidimension technique presentation through the use of multi-colored laser show, real surrounds sound system and more.
