DAY 4 · RELAXED START
FREE TIME IN SEVILLE.

Visit Cristina Heeren Foundation, a private flamenco dance school and beneficiary of a TreadRight Foundation grant. Put your rhythm to the test during a dance lesson, before witnessing emotions come to life in a flamenco performance. With free time for dinner, head to nearby Triana market where vendors are selling tapas and sangria made from fresh, local produce. (B)

DAY 5 · RELAXED START
TO LISBON.

Pass through the oak forests where black Iberian pigs are bred for the famous Spanish hams.

Stop in Huelva for a ham cutting demonstration and tasting of the freshest jamón ibérico. (B)

DAY 6 · RELAXED START
LISBON AND THE AGE OF THE DISCOVERIES.

See the Monument to the Discoveries and the Belém Tower before visiting the UNESCO World Heritage Site of Jerónimos Monastery with its beautiful Manueline architecture. The afternoon is at your leisure, to relax or continue exploring. (B)

DAY 7
HOLY FÁTIMA AND GOLDEN SALAMANCA.

Travel to Fátima, the most celebrated place of pilgrimage in Portugal and visit the famed basilica.

Cross the border and continue to Salamanca to see its golden stone buildings, the handsome arcades of the Plaza Mayor and the Puente Romano. (B)
