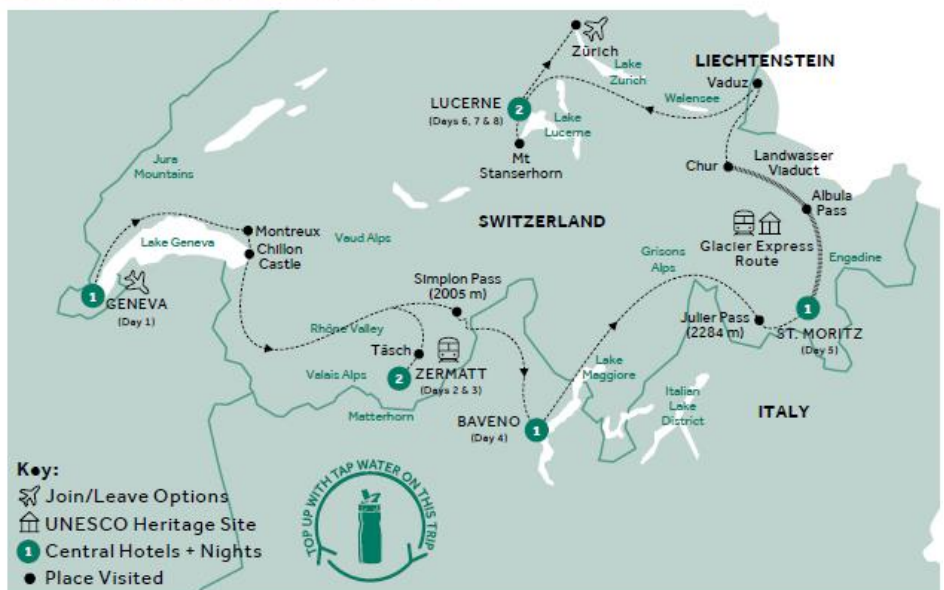

 **GENEVA, CITY OF GARDENS.**







DAY 2
 **Montreux, Chillon and the Matterhorn Village of Zermatt.**

ELEGANT BAVENO.

Descend to Täsch and rejoin the coach. Follow in Napoleon's footsteps as you ascend the Simplon Pass, taking in magnificent views over the Alps from the 2,000-metre summit. Continue along the gentle shores of Lake Maggiore. Perhaps take a delightful boat trip to see the stunning Isola Bella? (B)

 **SCENIC TRAIN RIDE, LIECHTENSTEIN AND LUCERNE.**




Start the day with a scenic train ride along part of the Glacier Express route, through unforgettable scenes of ice-capped mountains, stone-built villages and lush meadows.

 **THE SUMMIT OF STANSERHORN.**
