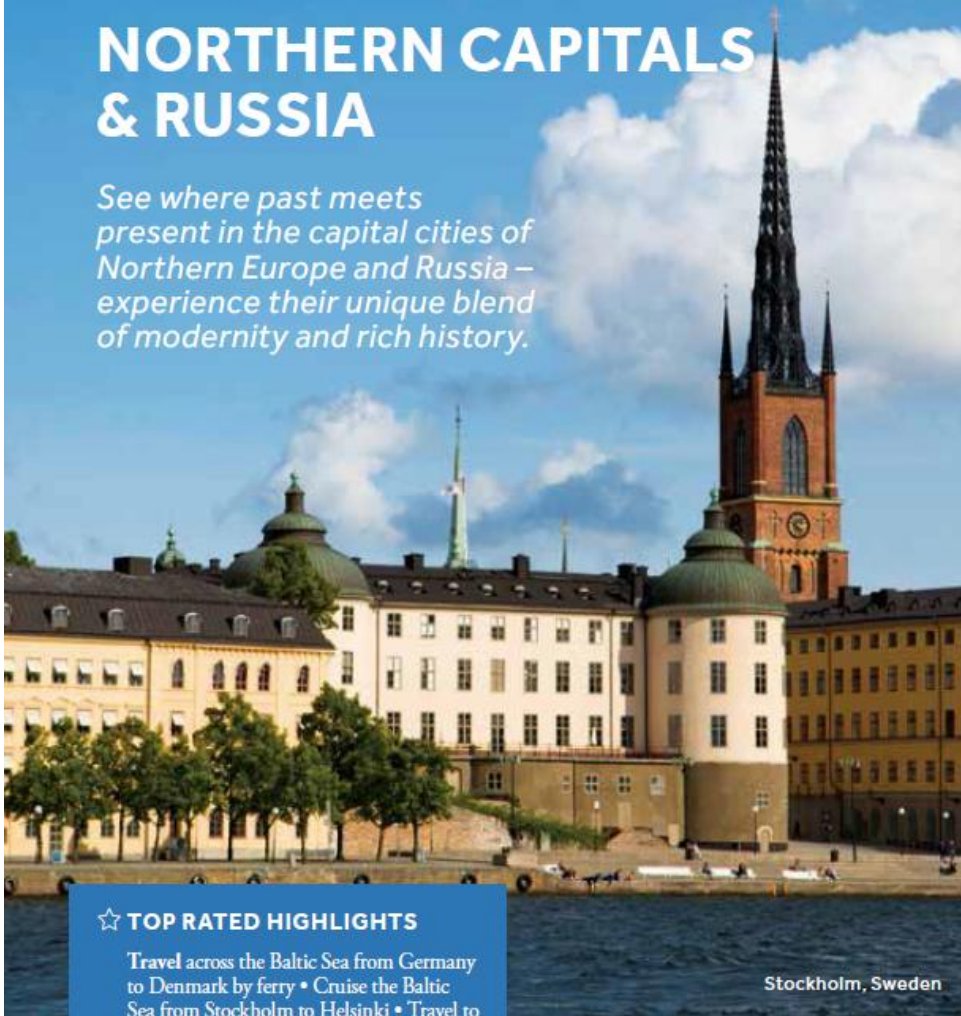



DAY 7 - RELAXED START
